

School Uniform (Riviera, Bayview, Greenways, Frogmore)

Summer

Senior summer School dress (worn at knee length or longer) with White school socks (short – non sport)

Summer shorts and white shirt with White school socks (short – non sport)

Grey shorts / dark grey long trousers with plain black belt and School summer socks

White shirt (long or short-sleeve) House tie may be worn

Black leather school shoes (T-bar or lace-up)

School blazer (for Assemblies, formal occasions and cooler days)

White or blue hair ribbon (white for formal occasions)

Riviera and Bayview Students must wear a School cap for all outside activities

Greenways and Frogmore Students are encouraged to wear a School cap while outdoors

Students in Years 5 – 12 may wear an MG School summer shirt without a tie during Terms 1 & 4 only

Winter

Winter skirt (worn at knee length or longer) with Navy coloured tights or stockings (optional) or White socks (long)

Navy Winter pants with black socks

Dark Grey trousers with plain black belt and black socks

White shirt (long or short sleeve)

House tie

School jumper – not to be worn as an outer garment outside the School

Black leather school shoes (T-bar or lace-up)

School blazer (to be worn to and from School, Assemblies and formal occasions)

School scarf (optional)

White or blue hair ribbon (white for formal occasions)

Sport Uniform

May be worn on sports training days and to weekend competitions

School tracksuit (optional)

School shorts – Navy or with logo

School House polo top (in-house competition only)

School White or Navy polo shirt with logo

School rugby top (optional)

White socks with appropriate Runners

School sports cap

School bathers (if applicable)

White or blue hair ribbon (if applicable)

School beanie (winter season only)

(School sport teams will have more specific uniform requirements and students will be advised by the coach)

General Uniform Expectations

Blazers are optional with the summer uniform; however, School jumpers are not to be worn as outer garment outside of the School unless wearing the summer shirt.

Blazers are required for assemblies and formal occasions. Prior notification will be given to students.

Correct uniform must be worn to and from School each day.

Year 9 students may wear their Greenways fleece in place of the School blazer.

All students must carry a Mentone Grammar backpack.

Students are required to wear Summer uniform in Terms 1 & 4 and Winter uniform in Terms 2 & 3.

Students are required to wear the standard or winter uniform to recognised formal occasions.

The wearing of rings and badges (School and House badges excepted) is not permitted with the School uniform.

All uniform items should be clearly labelled.

Blazers should be dry-cleaned at least twice per year.

Colours should be applied to blazers during holiday times.

HAIR, JEWELLERY AND MAKE-UP

Hair is to be a consistent, natural colour, no shorter than a No. 3 cut

No radical styles, e.g. undercuts, ridges etc

Hair which is collar length or longer must be tied back

Hair ties to be navy or white

Hair to be washed regularly

Senior boys are asked to be clean-shaven

No make-up or nail polish to be worn to school

Piercings – students may wear one small plain ear stud or sleeper per ear, through the earlobe

No additional jewellery is to be worn to school

No nose-rings or eye-rings are to be worn to school

Rings are not to be worn on fingers while in School uniform
