

**Please read the terms and conditions of this Scholarship before proceeding with your application:**

1. The parent/guardian/s accept the offer of a Mentone Grammar Community Scholarship for the Student on the terms and conditions of this agreement.
2. The parent/guardian/s are provided with a remission of tuition fees during the period of the scholarship as noted below subject to and conditional upon ongoing compliance by the Student and the parent/guardian/s with this agreement.
3. Families will be responsible for covering the costs of specific school-related items, including but not limited to school shoes, sports shoes, private music or drama tuition, and non-compulsory camps or study tours.
4. It is a condition of the Scholarship that the Student must remain enrolled at Mentone Grammar until they complete Year 12.
5. The Student must demonstrate to the reasonable satisfaction of the Principal throughout the period of the Scholarship a sound record of schoolwork and active participation in sport and other school activities in accordance with their ability and within the requirements of Mentone Grammar. The Principal will review the Student's progress and compliance with this condition at least annually.
6. The parent/guardian/s and the Student must comply with all Mentone Grammar rules and policies and other requirements concerning attendance, behaviour, conduct, dress, appearance and consistently demonstrate Mentone Grammar Learning Behaviours and School Values throughout the period of the Scholarship and must not engage in conduct which, in the reasonable opinion of the Principal, may diminish or cause harm to the integrity of the Scholarship or the reputation of Mentone Grammar. This includes adhering to relevant [School Policies](#) including the [Student Code of Conduct](#) which is supported by the [Parent Code of Conduct](#).
7. The Student must be enrolled in the year in which the scholarship commences, and enrolment cannot be deferred.
8. Mentone Grammar may terminate the Scholarship from the commencement of the next term from the date on which written notice of termination is given to the parent/guardian/s if, in the reasonable opinion of the Principal, they or the Student fail to comply with any of the terms of this agreement. In such cases, repayment of the Scholarship will not be required. However, the School may request the return of incidentals such as laptops, uniforms, and booklist items.
9. The parent/guardian/s agree to keep the award of the Scholarship and the terms of this agreement absolutely confidential.
