



Uniforms are accepted on a consignment basis.

Goods may be left at the P&F Shop during shop opening hours only. All consignments must be accompanied with a *Drop Off Form* which is available for download from the school website.

All items must be clean and in excellent second-hand condition.

It is essential you consult the *Drop Off Guide* (also available on the school website) prior to dropping off garments.

Our volunteers are not able to check your goods are at sale standard during shop hours. Please take care when selecting the goods you choose to include in your consignment as processing and disposal of items not fulfilling the *Drop Off Guide* requirements takes up many hours of volunteer time.

Only uniform items listed in our *Drop Off Guide* will be accepted and these must be branded in line with those sold via the Noone Uniform Shop.

Goods are sold at approximately 50-60% of the new retail value - 25% of that amount is retained as commission by the P&F, with monies raised allocated to a variety of school projects annually.

The remaining 75% of the sold price will be paid to consignors at the end of the term in which the goods were sold. This payment is made via EFT to the account details given at the time of drop off.

Parents are also welcome to donate the full proceeds of the sale to the P&F. Please advise your wish to do this at the time of drop off.

Garments found at checkout to be flawed may be discounted, written off or sent to charity.

Any items not sold after a period of 12 months or longer in the Shop, may be discounted, written off or sent to charity.

Whilst all care is taken by our volunteers, no responsibility for loss, theft or damage to consigned garments will be taken.
